Guest: Redi Regional Economic Development Inc group came to the meeting and spoke to the group on all the programs they have to offer.

P&Z are going to review the new plan they will make their recommendation to the Board of Alderman at the next meeting. Nate Kohl also spoke at the Council meeting explaining the new plan.

<u>Maintenance Department:</u> Derek Raps he has left a list for the Alderman to see what he has done the month of September.

Police Department: Thomas Crawford gave his report also with the question of what would the Alderman want him to work. They are leaving this up to Thomas as he sees fit. He will work eight hours a day five days a week. When he is on call and he is called in it will be a two-hour minimum.

The new Police Officer (Thomas Crawford) will be at the City Office on Halloween for a meet and greet he will also be handing out candy to all that stop by. The time will be 5:30pm to 6:30pm.

With all the help the Hallsville Police Department has given Thomas the City of Sturgeon would like to give the department a Certificate of Appreciation for all their help.

Fair Grounds Board: They are starting to have more and more events at the Fair Grounds all seems to be going well.

<u>Park and Tree Board</u>: Jennifer Campbell spoke to everyone at the meeting about the survey they had going around. She said most people did ask for the bathrooms to be open back up. Also, they are wanting a splash pad for the park. She also talked about all the improvements that are going to be made.

<u>Cemetery Committee:</u> There is a piece of land just West of the Cemetery that is being used at this time for farming. The Council would like to check into this and charge for the use of the land. They are also looking for more members right now to serve on the Cemetery Board. Other items needed a new sign at the entrance to the Cemetery. We need to consider creating a directory /map maybe a drone to take pictures.

<u>Planning & Zoning Commission:</u> Mike Jacoby spoke about the development agreement with Jesse Bailey. He got the public hearing in the paper this is phase one to the beginning of the new subdivision.

P&Z will also review the new road plan for the new subdivision and give the Council their recommendation.

BILL NO. 09-26-2022

ORDINANCE NO. 949

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 700.080.B OF THE STURGEON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF STURGEON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** That Section 700.080.B, Meter Deposits; Meter Connections is hereby changed, altered, and amended to read as follows:
 - B. Whenever any dwelling or any lot, parcel of land or premises shall become connected to the waterworks and sewage system of the City, the following connection charges shall be imposed (to include, but not limited to, lots that may have an old water meter connection that does not have a check valve or backflow device):
 - **Section 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- **Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect September 26, 2022 and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of Alderman and approval by the Mayor of the City of Sturgeon, Missouri.
 - **Section 4.** All other ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

Read two times by title only and PASSED by the Board of Aldermen this 26th day of September, 2022.

After much discussion it was in the best interest of the City to table this until the next meeting.

Tom Raterman with BCRSD spoke to the group about exactly what this means to have this resolution. This is a very normal resolution with Cities it is very helpful with all contractor's developers anyone who is working in the City will know what is expected this sixty-one page report will let everyone know what is required of them in the City of Sturgeon.

If we get the Wastewater Grant, we will use the money to dredge the lagoon. If we are awarded the Water Grant, we will buy Auto Matic meter readers.

Update on Park Project it is going very well the mulch is ordered should be here the first week in October. Bathrooms are being fix as we speak a new swing has been bought. More good stuff to come.

Discussion on future Maintenance Department Applications. We have applications out. The City of Sturgeon would like to hire one more person for the maintenance department.

Review Williams Keepers 6/30/22 Report came back letting the City know of the extra money in the General Account. The Mayor and Alderman are going to review the goals and what projects they want to move forward with. October 12, 2022 at 7:00pm everyone is welcome to come.

Review bid for one time lagoon mowing by BCRSD. Alderman Seth Truesdell made a motion to pay BCRSD a one-time fee of \$1,095.00 to mow the lagoon. The motion was second by Alderman Kevin Abrahamson with four in favor. After this is mowed it needs to be sprayed.

Review request for downtown parking spot marking. After much discussion the Alderman want the strip painted in front of the store. Crosswalks need to be painted. Alderman wants Derke to paint the crosswalks.

Review Recycle Bin proposal we can pay money to get the recycle bin picked up two times a week share the cost with other cities. Mayor did ask the Alderman do you want him to check into this.
